

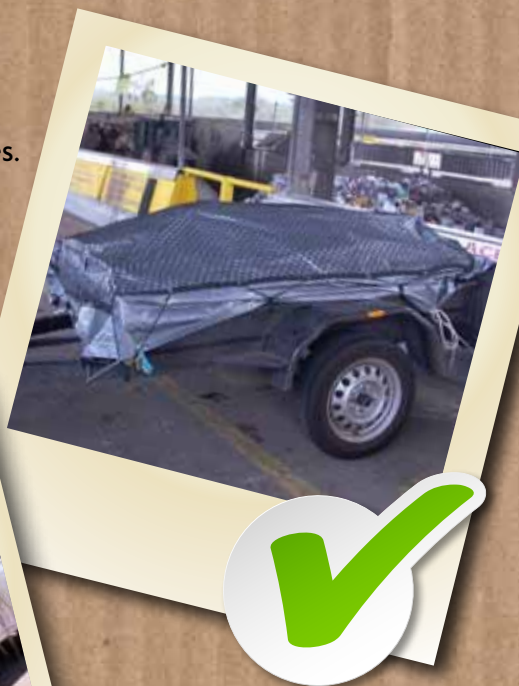
SECURING AND SORTING MY GREEN WASTE LOAD

ALL LOADS MUST BE SECURED

GREEN WASTE needs to be effectively secured and covered so that it cannot come off in transit.

If you don't secure your load properly you can be fined by the police or for a serious breach, be prosecuted in court. Harsher penalties apply for heavy vehicles.

SORTING SAVES TIME

The Riverview and Rosewood Recycling & Refuse Centres accept a variety of materials for disposal; many of which can be sent offsite for recycling. Diverting waste from landfill reduces the Centres landfill costs and ultimately their disposal charges.

By taking a little extra time to sort your load before you leave home, you can save yourself time at the Recycling & Refuse Centres and also make the most of the recycling facilities.

For your safety always follow the directions of the weighbridge staff and site attendants.

LOADING TIPS

- Keep like materials grouped together in your vehicle or trailer. Indiscriminately throwing all items together makes it very difficult to sort at the Recycling & Refuse Centre.
- **Riverview Recycling & Refuse Centre:** Load green waste first, then recycling, then rubbish for the pit. This allows you to drop off your rubbish first then move on to the recycling and green waste drop-off areas.
- **Rosewood Recycling & Refuse Centre:** Due to the layout of the Centre, the order of loading doesn't matter; you just need to group like materials together and then unload them in the correct areas.
