

Eastern Suburbs Pubs Then & Now



Royal Mail, 92 Brisbane Terrace Goodna:
There has been a Royal Mail Hotel at Goodna since the 1860s when the area was on the main road to Brisbane.

The present-day hotel, apparently not on the same site as the original, was built in 1894.





Kerwick Hotel, Redbank: The Kerwick is named after Nicholas Kerwick who was born in Kilkenny Ireland but spent most of his youth in the north of England. He came to Ipswich and worked on the Brisbane Valley Railway line, then lived at Redbank for several years. Later he became the licensee of the One Mile Hotel.
