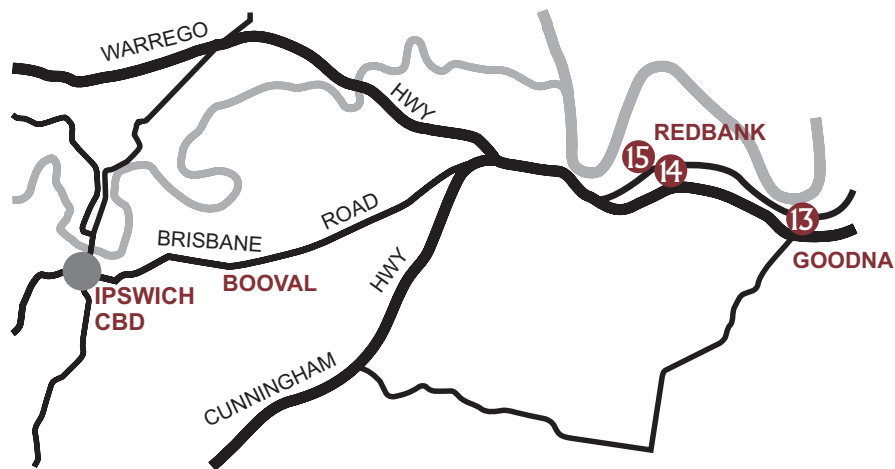


# Eastern Suburbs Pubs Then & Now



- 13 Royal Mail, 92 Brisbane Terrace Goodna:** There has been a Royal Mail Hotel at Goodna since the 1860s when the area was on the main road to Brisbane.  
The present-day hotel, apparently not on the same site as the original, was built in 1894.



- 15 Commercial Hotel, Redbank:** A handsome two-storey timber building, believed to have been constructed about 1910. The verandahs were enclosed for many years but were opened up again in the late 1980s, returning the hotel to almost its original form.



- 14 Kerwick Hotel, Redbank:** The Kerwick is named after Nicholas Kerwick who was born in Kilkenny Ireland but spent most of his youth in the north of England. He came to Ipswich and worked on the Brisbane Valley Railway line, then lived at Redbank for several years. Later he became the licensee of the One Mile Hotel.
