## Application Criteria

To apply, complete the application form and submit the following relevant information:

- your experience in your chosen discipline
- one letter of reference from one teacher or professional
- the financial and associated details of workshop/performance to be attended.

### AIMS

The grant aims to:

- Support cultural diversity through excellence in the arts, specifically performing arts in Ipswich. e.g. Theatre, Music, Dance, Voice, Instrument (both individual and group).
- Provide an avenue of recognition of local talent.
- Stimulate regional opportunities in performing arts through the:-
  - a. provision of this encouragement award; and
  - b. allocated financial support.
- Enrich the quality of life through fostering cultural development and growth of participation in the arts.
- Reflect the goals and strategies as outlined in the Ipswich City Council Corporate Plan and Cultural Policy.

### CRITERIA

Applications considered are to address the following criteria:

1. Applicants must be residents of Ipswich.
2. Applicants must be under 25 years.
3. Applications must be for specific professional development in areas as discussed above which demonstrates significant representation or recognition within specific disciplines eg. state or national competitions, workshops or tutorial opportunities.
5. Applicants may apply once per year or to an annual maximum of \$300.

### CONDITIONS OF AWARD

1. Recipient must demonstrate a preparedness to participate in at least one local recital. This will be negotiated on case by case basis through the Ipswich City Council, Economic and Cultural Development Department.
2. Any changes to the purpose of the grant, the time-frame or personnel involved are to be approved and negotiated through the Ipswich City Council, Economic and Cultural Development Department.
3. Grants to be awarded must follow budgetary allocations listed in the applications.

### METHOD OF APPLICATION

The Application must be on Council's official Young Performing Artist Bursary Application Form addressed to the Chief Executive Officer, Ipswich City Council. It is also to include one letter of support from acknowledged persons within the specific area of discipline. The application may include additional support material. Financial and associated details of the workshop/performance must also be included.

### FUNDING ROUNDS

Applicants will be considered on an ongoing basis, however a minimum of one months notice is required.
