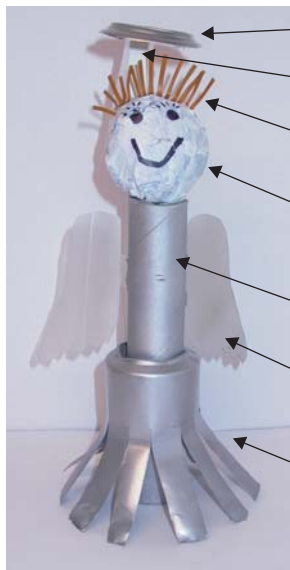
To make Christmas decorations out of recyclable/sustainable materials, you will need the following:

- **USED PAPER** (newspaper, wrapping paper, junk mail, letters)
- **CARDBOARD** (cereal boxes, milk or juice cartons, paper towel/cling wrap rolls)
- **PLASTIC BOTTLES & CONTAINERS** (soft drink or milk bottles, ice cream containers, any other plastic items with a recyclable sign)
- **ALUMINIUM CANS** (soft drink cans. Please note this may not be suitable for smaller children)
- **STEEL CANS** (baked bean/spaghetti/tuna etc., cans. Please note this may not be suitable for smaller children)
- **GLUE/STICKY TAPE**
- **SCISSORS**
- **PAINT, COLOURED PENCILS/PENS**
- **ANYTHING ELSE TO MAKE THEM PRETTY!**
- **NO PLASTIC BAGS!**

Ask students to collect a variety of recyclable materials from home and bring them into school to make into their Christmas decorations. Once their finished they could take their creations and give them to their parents to pop on the Christmas Tree!

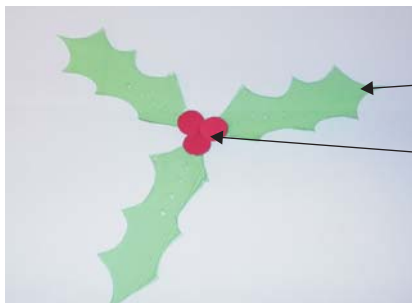
Examples of Christmas decorations
