

## National Recycling Week Competition

### Terms and Conditions

1. Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these Conditions of Entry. Entry into the National Recycling Week Competition ("the Competition") is deemed acceptance of these conditions of entry.
2. Entry is open to all Australian residents. Employees of Ipswich City Council, are ineligible to enter.
3. The competition commences on Monday 22 October 2007 at 00:01 (EST) and concludes on Friday 16 November at 16:30 (EST) ("Competition Period").
4. To enter and be eligible to win a prize, an eligible entrant must, during the Competition Period:
  - a. Design and make a Christmas decoration out of recyclable materials.
  - b. Entry forms must be submitted to Ipswich Waste Service by mail to: PO Box 191 Ipswich QLD 4305, or by email to: [ipswichwasteservices@ipswich.qld.gov.au](mailto:ipswichwasteservices@ipswich.qld.gov.au), by 16:30 (EST) on Friday 16 November 2007.
5. A person may only enter the Competition once.
6. Each entry will be deemed to be accepted when it has been received by an Ipswich Waste Services staff member during the Competition Period by mail or email. Incomplete or incomprehensible entries will be deemed invalid.
7. The prize draw will be conducted at the Ipswich Waste Services, Briggs Road Flinders View QLD 4305 on Monday 19 November 2007.
8. The winner will be notified by telephone or mail and will receive a visit by their local Councillor to present the prize at the school assembly, at a mutually arranged time between both parties before the end of the 4<sup>th</sup> school term in 2007.
9. Prizes will be awarded in four categories. 1. Prep: "Cut" small bag and small pencil case. 2. Grades 1 to 3: Lunch bag and small pencil case. 3. Grades 4 and 5: Homework folder, book cover and large pencil case. 4. Grades 6 and 7: "Kitchen Sink" shoulder bag and large pencil case. Prize value \$287. All prizes have been kindly donated by XS Project Foundation.
10. Each winner will also be awarded a set of sustainability-based educational books for their school. Titles are 'World Wide Waste', 'Water, the Amazing Journey', 'It's a Climate for Change', 'A Worm's Eye View' and 'Where does the Poo Go?' Prize value for each set is \$90.
11. Total prize value is \$647.
