\* For category 1 residential owner occupiers the average increase in the general rate will be 3.52% or 71 cents per week. Flood recovery work will make up 1.88% or 38 cents per week of this amount. Without the flood and the anticipated additional repair costs over and above that funded from state and federal funds, the general rate increase would have been 33 cents per week or 1.64%. The additional 38 cents per week allows Council to borrow \$28M specifically for flood repair work. The net increase for residential owner occupiers for all council services including the state government fire levy, cleansing charge and environmental levy will be 4.9% or \$1.26 per week.
