It should be noted that the erection of election signs is subject to the conditions set out below.

- Election signs shall **not**:
 - Be erected in any road or in any park or land under the control of Council except on an approved Advertising Device. Any such sign which is erected contrary to this condition may be removed by Council.
 - Be an illuminated sign nor a sign made of reflective materials.
 - Be erected so that it interferes with the safety and visibility of vehicular or pedestrian traffic.
- The Bond shall be refunded to the applicant provided that all signs are removed within fourteen (14) days after the date of the election to which the signs refer. Council shall arrange for the removal of such signs after the expiration of the above period and dispose of such signs as it deems fit.

The attached refund request and statutory declaration are to be returned to Council after the date of the election to enable the refund of the Bond.

Information Privacy Collection Notice

Ipswich City Council is collecting your personal information in accordance with the Local Law 50 – Signs and Advertisements so that we can process your application and perform our responsibilities under the Local Law. Erection of Election Signs

Each Candidate shall, in relation to the erection of signs:-

1. Obtain Council permission prior to erection of election signs by completing the prescribed form stating the purpose of the signs and the proposed locations of the signs, and lodging the form with Council's Planning and Development Department.
2. Pay to Council the Bond amount as detailed in Council's Fees and Charges. Such Bond shall be refunded to the applicant provided that all signs are removed within fourteen (14) days after the date of the election to which the signs refer, and further, that for each and every sign not removed, the sum of \$50.00 shall be forfeited to the Council from the amount deposited and the Council shall arrange for the removal of such signs after the expiration of the above period and dispose of such signs as it deems fit.
3. Not erect or cause to be erected any election sign or signs on any road or in any park or land under the control of Council except on an approved Advertising Device. Any such sign which is erected contrary to this condition may be removed by Council.
4. Not erect any illuminated sign nor sign made of reflective materials.
5. Not erect any sign that interferes with the safety and visibility of vehicular or pedestrian traffic.
