

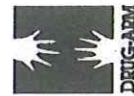
Safe Needle Disposal

A discarded needle in a public place could cause a needle stick injury and possibly serious health concerns. To try and reduce the risk of a needle-stick injury occurring, it is important that the public become aware of how and where they can dispose of needles safely.

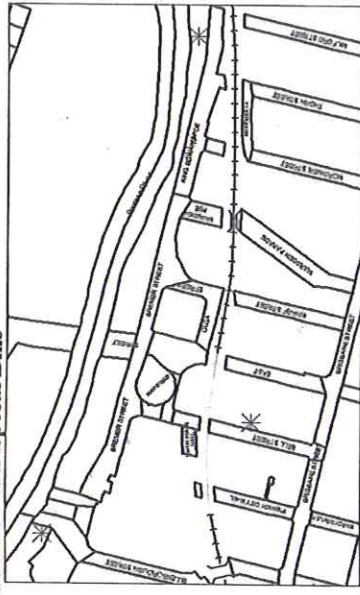
Sharps disposal bins are located at the following sites:

1. Bremer Street, Ipswich. located near the railway bridge
2. Next to the footpath leading to Bob Gamble Park, East Ipswich
3. Toilets at Leichhardt Park, Old Toowoomba Road, One Mile
4. Toilets at Alf Harris Park, Queen Street, Goodna
5. The entrance to the Ipswich Health Plaza Car Park, Bell Street, Ipswich
6. The Warwick Road entrance to the Ipswich Hospital
7. Goodna Community Centre Car Park, Queen Street, Goodna

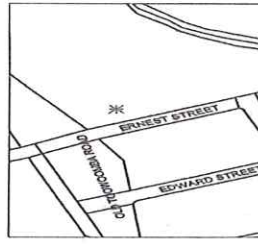

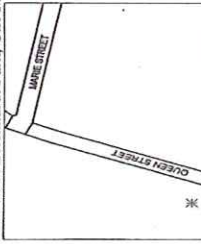
Location of Disposal Bins
