

## National Recycling Week Competition

### Terms and Conditions

Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these Conditions of Entry. Entry into the National Recycling Week Competition ("the Competition") is deemed acceptance of these conditions of entry.

#### WHO MAY ENTER

1. Entry is open to all Australian residents who are not employees of, or contractors to Ipswich City Council or any of its agencies.

#### DURATION

2. This competition commences on Monday, 6 October 2008 at 00:01 (EST) and concludes on Friday, 14 November at 16:30 (EST) ("Competition Period").

#### HOW TO ENTER

3. To enter and be eligible to win a prize, an eligible entrant must, during the Competition Period:
  - a. Design and make a Christmas decoration out of rubbish and recyclable materials.
  - b. Entries must be submitted to Ipswich Waste Service by mail to: PO Box 191 Ipswich QLD 4305, or the environmental education officer must be booked to pick up entries from the school by 16:30 (EST) on Friday 14 November 2008. Alternatively, entries can be submitted in person at Ipswich Waste Services Reception, 180-250 Briggs Road, Flinders View.
  - c. School entries must have the name of entrant, entrant's age and school attached to the decoration.
  - d. Community group and individual entries must have the entrants name, category for which they are entering and contact telephone number attached to the decoration.
4. Each entry will be deemed to be accepted when it has been received by an Ipswich Waste Services staff member during the Competition Period. Incomplete or incomprehensible entries will be deemed invalid.

#### LIMITATIONS ON ENTRY

5. A person or collective school class/community group may only enter the Competition once.

#### SELECTION OF WINNERS

#### PRIZES
