

APPROVED INSPECTION PROGRAM FOR AUDIT OF WATER USE FOR IPSWICH WATER AND IPSWICH CITY COUNCIL

(Local Government Act 1993 – Division 7 Approved Inspection Programs 1099 Notice of proposed inspection program)

PURPOSE OF THE SYSTEMATIC INSPECTION PROGRAM

Council has chosen to implement a Systematic Inspection Program which will allow entry to all places in the local government area, including properties used for residential, commercial, industrial or other uses, for the purpose of investigating potential breaches of current water restrictions and to audit water consumption.

The Authorised Officers will only be entering properties connected to Council's Water Supply Network.

Properties within this area must be compliant with water restrictions. The Authorised Officers will not be entering buildings or structures used for electrical purposes.

The falling level of the SEQ Regional Dam supply and implementation of SEQ Regional Water Restrictions have resulted in an increased need to ensure compliance with water restrictions and reduce water wastage.

PROGRAM COMMENCEMENT

This program will commence at 6.00 am on Wednesday 12 December, 2007.

PROGRAM COMPLETION

This program will cease at 6.00 am on Tuesday 11 March, 2007.
