# Rosewood Wastewater Centre

Rosewood Wastewater Centre currently services a population of approximately 2,600 people.

The original trickling filter plant, commissioned in the late 1960's was replaced in 1999. The new facility utilises a batch extended aeration process, where the effluent is discharged intermittently. Secondary effluent then passes through four lagoons, three of which have been converted to wetlands.

Disinfected reclaimed water is either discharged to Western Creek or used for irrigation of the Rosewood Golf Course. Waste activated biosolids are directed to a lagoon prior to offsite disposal.
