

## Rosewood Wastewater Centre

Warrill View Road, Rosewood Q 4340

First commissioned in the late 1960's, the Rosewood Wastewater Centre is our smallest and oldest treatment plant. It presently services the township of Rosewood with an operating capacity of 3 000 equivalent persons (EP).

Rosewood Wastewater Centre was augmented in 1999 and utilises an Intermittently Decanted Extended Aeration (IDEA) process. Wastewater passes through a series of lagoons prior to disinfection with sodium hypochlorite.

### Class B Recycled Water

The Rosewood Wastewater Centre also houses one of our tanker filling points supplying Class B recycled water. Ipswich Water's recycled water initiative aims at encouraging the use of this alternative source where it is 'fit for purpose' for sustainable business and industry practices. Some of the reclaimed water from the centre is used by the Rosewood Golf Course for irrigation purposes.
