STAGE 3 NIGHTWORKS

On Friday 25, Sunday 27 and Monday 28 October 2024, nightwork is required to progress road construction and electrical infrastructure works on Springfield Greenbank Arterial, Main Street and the Centenary Motorway Exit 32 off ramp, Springfield Central. Nightwork will be completed from 7pm to 5am with all roads open to live traffic at 5am on Tuesday 29 October 2024.

WORKS WILL INCLUDE:

- Installation of electrical street lighting, traffic signal networks and poles
- Electrical cable hauling
- Minor earthworks
- Asphaltting of road surface layers on Springfield Greenbank Arterial from Main Street towards Sinnathamby Boulevard

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Changed traffic conditions including temporary partial lane closures of Centenary Motorway Exit 32 off ramp, Main Street and Springfield Greenbank Arterial. Motorists will be detoured into Springfield Central via Centenary Motorway Exit 33 and Sinnathamby Boulevard.
- Springfield Central Park'n'Ride entry and exit will be open for the duration.
- Traffic control signage, vehicles and controllers to direct traffic.
- Reduced speed limit to 40km/h through work areas.
- Translink buses will be directed through work areas under traffic control.

- Temporary footpath closures near the work areas will occur and alternative pedestrian routes will be signed.
- Some minor noise and dust associated with these activities. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts.

SPRINGFIELD CENTRAL PARK'N'RIDE OPEN

For the duration the Springfield Central Park'n'Ride entry and exit will be opened and left turn exit only. Motorists will be directed to exit the Park'n'Ride under traffic control.
