Flood Recovery Project Update



Colleges Crossing Reserve Flood Recovery Update December 2022

Council is currently working through a number of stages to form planning and redevelopment of the Colleges Crossing Reserve site following recent flooding including environmental safety (eg land contamination testing and minor works to prepare the site). The stages can be subject to change depending on weather, contractor and supply variables due to current market conditions. In 2023 Council will be communicating more information on the stages and estimated timeframes.

It is unlikely that any significant on-ground works (construction) will commence before July 2023. We acknowledge that Colleges Crossing Reserve is very popular with the Ipswich and surrounding community and there is a strong desire to use the reserve. However, Council needs to ensure a level of safety to the community. In the meantime, Ipswich has a variety of parks and reserves available, more information can be found at:
