FAQ'S

How long does it take?

On average submitting a nomination takes less than 30 minutes.

Can I nominate myself?

No, all nominees must be nominated by a third party.

Can I nominate more than one person or community group? Yes.

Can I send my nomination via mail? No, nominations can only be submitted online via the official nomination portal.

Who judges the nominations?

A group of representatives from the Ipswich community.

Do I have to include a referee?

Yes, including a referee is critical for the nomination.

Can I nominate the same person more than once?

No, nominating someone multiple times does not add merit to their nomination. The selection panel will assess each nomination against the eligibility, category and judging criteria.
