

### Major Projects and Initiatives

#### **Budget Overview**

More money than ever before will be invested in roads, bridges and community facilities under Ipswich City Council's 2017-2018 Budget.

The environment is another big winner with funding for conservation estates, supporting koala and platypus populations and promoting sustainability through popular community events.

A bumper line-up of arts, cultural and heritage programs will also be delivered.

Highlights include \$4 million for upgrading Old Toowoomba Road to four lanes between Lobb Street and Toongarra Road and more than \$3.2 million for the development of the Briggs Road criterium facility at Raceview.

Leichhardt's George Alder Tennis Centre will be upgraded with \$204,000 set aside for the installation of new lighting and an acrylic playing surface.
