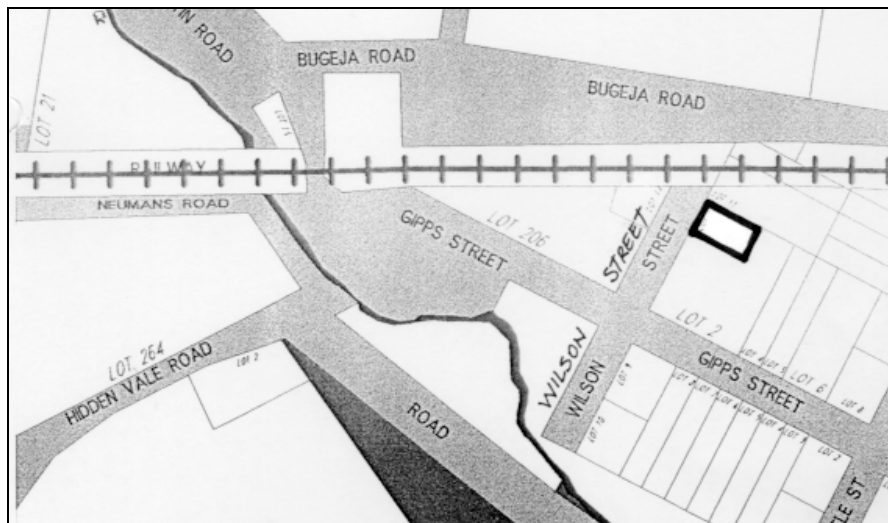

History:

Description: A lowset timber railway house with corrugated galvanised iron roof, weatherboard cladding, enclosed front verandah, detached kitchen wing. Two skillion-roofed later extensions. The setting includes a large tree to the north-west of the house. Building exhibits some original window hoods. There are a number of unsympathetic alterations.

Significance:

This property is a place of cultural heritage significance and satisfies one or more of the criteria in Division 13.6 of Local Law 30 of the Ipswich Town Planning Scheme as evidenced by, but not exclusive to, the following statement of significance, based on **Criteria a, d, e, g**.

It is important in exhibiting a range of aesthetic characteristics valued by the community, in particular the building's traditional form, scale and materials. It makes an important contribution to the landscape.

It is closely associated with the development of railway transport along this historic rail corridor and is associated with the development of the small township of Calvert.

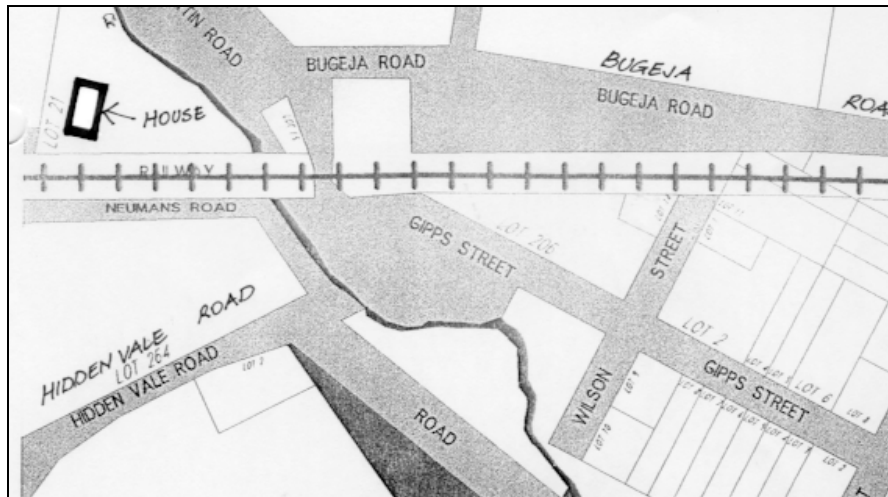
