Springfield Parkway and Springfield Greenbank Arterial Road Upgrade

STAGE 3

To safely implement, construct and progress the next phase of works of the Springfield Parkway and Springfield Greenbank Arterial duplication project, nightwork is required.

From Sunday night 12 November until Friday morning 8 December 2023, night works will occur at Centenary Motorway Exit 32 off ramp, Main Street intersection, and Springfield Greenbank Arterial between Eden Station Drive and Sinnathamby Boulevard Springfield.

Works will include:

- Road excavation for road crossings to facilitate storm water and water main works, street light installation and electrical service works
- Relocation of traffic barriers and fencing to facilitate work zones on the Centenary Motorway Exit 32 off ramp.

To facilitate these works, Springfield Park'n'Ride, Main Street intersection and Springfield Greenbank Arterial between Eden Station Drive and Sinnathamby Bouvard will need to be periodically partially or fully closed. Variable message signs and traffic signage will advise of these changed traffic conditions. Motorists, buses, pedestrians and cyclists will be directed through the work areas under traffic control and motorists are advised to drive to the changed traffic conditions.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Traffic control signage, vehicles and controllers to direct traffic.
- Periodic temporary partial or full road closures of Main Street intersection, Springfield Greenbank Arterial and the Springfield Park'n'Ride.



- Night closures of the Park'n'Ride entry Monday to Thursday 7pm to 5am, motorists will be able to exit the Park'n'Ride at all times.
- Reduced speed limit to 40km/h through work areas.
- There will be no impact to Translink bus services for the duration. Buses will be directed under traffic control.
- Installation and relocation of safety barriers and fencing.
- Limited pedestrian access around the construction area. Temporary footpath closures near the work area will occur and alternative routes will be signed.

NIGHTWORKS

- During night works vehicles will use 'quacker' style reversing alarms rather than beepers to reduce noise.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to nearby residences.
- All efforts will be made to minimise dust and noise with some noisier activities being completed prior to 10.30pm.


