Robelle Domain

Located in Springfield Central, Robelle Domain is a jewel in the crown of the City of Ipswich. The parklands offer a rainforest walk, waterfalls, water playground, bike tracks, the country's first Icon on Galaxy interactive play equipment in an all-abilities playground, a variety of dining options and monthly markets. Whether you enjoy a casual stroll, kicking a ball with the kids, splashing around in the water, a leisurely latté or some serious exercise, you can do it all here.

Orion Lagoon

Vast interconnected pools cater for all age groups, from the toddler-friendly 0.3 metres up to 1.5 metres for more proficient swimmers. Shade is provided by colourful sails and trees over grassed areas, while there's also a covered barbecue pavilion with picnic tables. Children under 13 must be actively supervised at all times.

The Circle

A feature area incorporating a 5,000 capacity amphitheatre, large modern stage and an expansive lawn that hosts regular jazz afternoons and markets. At night the 9-metre high light tower installations give off an impressive sound and light show.





Play

Children's faces light up when they see Robelle Domain's incredible playground and the sound of water cascading from the spectacular 700 litre tipping bucket in the zero depth water play area. All ages are entertained with voice pipes and drums for toddlers through to interactive electronic play for teens.

Dine

Enjoy a BBQ with friends and family, pack a picnic, or even sit down to a meal at Robelle Café or Lagoon Café. Springfield Markets are held on the first Friday of every month from 3.00 pm - 8.00 pm offering a variety of exotic flavours from local foodies and food trucks, along with performing artists and arts and crafts stalls.





This park remains sacred to the Traditional Owners of Ipswich, the Yagara People, consisting of the Jagera, Yuggera and Ugarapul Clans. Sacred sites are very important to the Traditional Owners, as they provide a link between Country and personal identity and allow the passing on of cultural knowledge. Some of the sacred sites within Ipswich include quarry sites, traditional food resources, story places, pre-contact and historical camp sites, fighting grounds, ceremonial sites, bora rings and women's business sites.
