1. **LAW NAME:** Subordinate Local Law No. 32 - Pedestrian Malls
2. **PURPOSE AND GENERAL EFFECT:** The objects of this Subordinate Local Law are to provide detailed information called upon by Local Law No. 32 - Pedestrian Malls to enable the Council to:
 - (a) provide for and encourage public access, use and enjoyment of pedestrian malls for both active and passive recreation; and
 - (b) ensure that such access, use and enjoyment occurs consistently with the preservation and enhancement of public safety and amenity; and
 - (c) protect and preserve the facilities installed within pedestrian malls and all aspects of the environment within pedestrian malls.

SUBORDINATE LOCAL LAW NO. 32 - PEDESTRIAN MALLS

Citation

1. This subordinate local law may be cited as Subordinate Local Law No. 32 - Pedestrian Malls.

Objects

2. The objects of this subordinate local law is to provide detailed information called upon by Local Law No. 32 - Pedestrian Malls to enable the Council to:
 - (a) Provide for and encourage public access, use and enjoyment of pedestrian malls for both active and passive recreation; and
 - (b) Ensure that such access, use and enjoyment occurs consistently with the preservation and enhancement of public safety and amenity; and

- (c) Protect and preserve the facilities installed within pedestrian malls and all aspects of the environment within pedestrian malls.

Approval of Vehicles

- 3. For the purposes of Section 8(2) of the local law, an application for approval of a vehicle under Section 8(1) of the local law must contain:
 - (a) name of applicant
 - (b) address of applicant
 - (c) telephone number of applicant during business hours
 - (d) type and make of vehicle
 - (e) registration number of vehicle
 - (f) purpose for which approval is sought
 - (g) commencement date of approval sought
 - (h) expiry date of approval sought
 - (i) signature of applicant
 - (j) date of application

Permit for Animals

4. For the purposes of Section 13(2)(b) of the local law an application for a permit under Section 13(1) of the local law must include the following information:
- (a) name of applicant
 - (b) address of applicant
 - (c) telephone number of applicant during business hours
 - (d) name of contact person
 - (e) type of animal or animals for which approval is sought
 - (f) purpose for which approval is sought
 - (g) location in mall sought to conduct an activity with and animal or animals
 - (h) whether electric power is required
 - (i) whether there are any other special requirements
 - (j) estimate of any set up and or dismantling of fittings times
 - (k) public liability policy number
 - (l) evidence of currency of public liability policy
 - (m) commencement date of approval sought
 - (n) expiry date of approval sought
 - (o) signature of applicant
 - (p) date of application

Permit for Certain Conduct

5. For the purposes of Section 16(1) of the local law an application for a permit under Section 15(3) of the local law must contain:
- (a) name of applicant
 - (b) address of applicant
 - (c) telephone number during business hours of applicant
 - (d) particular area of mall for which approval is sought

- (e) commencement date of approval
- (f) expiry date of approval
- (g) purpose for which approval is sought
- (h) whether power is required
- (i) special requirements
- (j) estimate of any set up and or dismantling of fittings times
- (k) public liability policy number
- (l) evidence of currency of public liability policy
- (m) commencement date of approval sought
- (n) expiry date of approval sought
- (o) signature of applicant
- (p) date of application
