

Survey Competition

Terms and Conditions of Entry



1. Ipswich City Council of 45 Roderick Street, Ipswich, Queensland are the promoters (“Promoters”) of the Hardings Paddock Visitor Survey (the “Competition”).
2. The Competition opens at 8.00 am Sunday 31 March 2019 and closes at 12.00 am Tuesday 30 April 2019 (“Competition Period”). Any entry received outside of the Competition Period will be invalid. The Promoters do not accept any responsibility for late, lost, delayed or misdirected entries.
3. The winner of the Competition will receive a \$100 Visa gift card – there is only one to be won (total competition value of \$100).
4. The prizes will be drawn at 10.00 am on Wednesday 1 May 2019 and the winner will be notified via the email address supplied during entry.
5. Prizes are not redeemable and/or exchangeable for compensation in cash or kind.
6. The Competition may be cancelled without notice.
7. Entry to the competition is free and open to all except for Council officers working directly on the Hardings Paddock Visitor Survey project.
8. All eligible people who complete the Hardings Paddock Visitor Survey will be automatically entered into the prize draw.
9. Entry to the Competition is open to individuals 18 years of age or older. Companies and organisations are ineligible for entry to the Competition.
10. The results of the Competition will not be published.
11. In the event that the winner has not claimed their prize within 72 hours, a re-draw will take place and a new winner selected from the existing entrants.
12. Each entry to the Competition must be entered in accordance with these Terms and Conditions. By entering the Competition, each entrant agrees to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. The Promoters may in their discretion refuse to award any prize to any entrant who fails to comply with the Terms and Conditions.
13. The decisions of the judges in relation to ALL competition matters are final and no correspondence and/or communication of any kind in relation to their decisions will be entered into.
14. Entrants must not engage in any unlawful or improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the Competition.
15. By entering the Competition each entrant agrees to indemnify the Promoters against all claims for loss, damage, costs (including legal costs) or liability whatsoever arising out of or in connection with the entrant’s breach of the Terms and Conditions.
16. The entrant shall indemnify and release the Promoters in respect of any judgements, action, or liability for all loss, damage or injury to persons or property arising from the negligence of the entrant or against any breach by the entrant of any third party intellectual property rights and against any act or omission of the entrant commenced by a third party against the Promoters.
17. Ipswich City Council is collecting your personal information so that we can administer and judge your Entry in the Hardings Paddock Visitor Survey Competition. We will not disclose your personal information outside of Council unless we are required by law or you have given your consent. However, to enable the Council to administer, judge and promote the Competition your personal information may be recorded and/or disclosed; for instance your name may be disclosed in a publication or at an event for the purpose of giving notice of Competition winners/entrants. Personal information may be used to contact entrants for the promotion of Council events and programs. By entering the Competition, each entrant will be considered to have given consent for Council to manage your personal information in the manner described in Council’s Privacy Statement, Personal Information Digest and this collection notice.
18. The completed and submitted entry form is evidence of the entrant’s acceptance of these terms and conditions.
19. The decision of the Promoter to accept or reject an entry, or a decision of the Promoter on any other aspect of the Competition is final. No correspondence will be entered into.
