Ripley Road Timber Bridge Replacement

July 2019

The project

Ipswich City Council is replacing the Ripley Road Timber Bridge, originally constructed circa 1945, with a single span structure.

Council is undertaking a design and construct project for the replacement. The contract for design will be awarded soon and is expected to commence August 2019. Construction is scheduled for late 2019 with completion in early 2020 (weather permitting).

Bridge closure and detour

There was a 4T load limit applied to the bridge given its poor condition. Unfortunately this limit was not being adhered to and Council needed to close the bridge with immediate effect in April 2019.

Traffic is detoured via Providence Parade, Parkway Avenue and Bayliss Road for the duration of council's project. A secondary detour is in place (short term) for works occuring near the new school (see map on next page).
