Small Business Funding Program

Ipswich City Council Small Business Funding Program (Round 2) provides funding for four (4) funding areas. This factsheet will examine the **Membership** funding area.

What providers are eligible under the membership category?

- Greater Springfield Chamber of Commerce
- Ipswich Region Chamber of Commerce (and Bremer Region Chamber of Commerce)
- state or national recognised associations and/or bodies (e.g. National Retailers Association)
- accreditation providers (e.g. Chartered Accountants or Queensland Law Society).

What is not eligible under the membership category?

- Chambers of Commerce not based in the Ipswich local government area
- recreational membership (e.g. Golf Club memberships)
- food licencing
- liquor licencing
- permits and/or applications.

What information do I need to provide for the application?

- name of Membership Association
- total cost of items
- a justification about how the inventory will assist your business to recover from financial impacts of COVID-19
- supporting documentation
 - quote or invoice from membership provider/ association including proposed works, or
 - receipt of payment or balanced invoice
