

What **CAN'T** go in your recycle bin?

NEVER PUT IN YOUR RECYCLING BIN

- × Batteries
- × Broken glassware
- × Bubble wrap and shrink wrap
- × Ceramics
- × Clothing, shoes and textiles
- × Crockery
- × Dirty tissues or serviettes
- × Disposable nappies
- × Electrical wire
- × Fishing line
- × Food scraps
- × Garbage
- × Garden and lawn clippings

- × Light bulbs
- × Mirrors or plate glass
- Packaging not requiring refrigeration (e.g. long life milk, milk products, juices)
- × Plastic bags
- × Pyrex ovenware
- × Scrap metal and other car parts
- × Styrofoam
- × Syringes
- × Toys
- × Waxed
- cardboard/paper
- × Wire coat hangers
