WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

Council is currently investigating road construction of Springfield Parkway duplication from Springfield Greenbank Arterial to Topaz Road- Stage 2.

WHEN WILL THIS WORK TAKE PLACE?

Start	November 2023 (<i>weather and site conditions permitting</i>)
Finish	December 2023 (<i>weather and site conditions permitting</i>)
Time and day	Works will be undertaken for a period between 8am- 4pm

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR ME?

This stage of the project requires Survey and Geotechnical teams to gather data for design purposes. These teams will be in the area soon (see map showing approximate extents overleaf).

Access to some private property may be required and Council will contact these properties directly to organise access.
