

Major Projects and Initiatives

Budget Overview

More money than ever before will be invested in roads, bridges and community facilities under Ipswich City Council's 2017-2018 Budget.

The environment is another big winner with funding for conservation estates, supporting koala and platypus populations and promoting sustainability through popular community events.

A bumper line-up of arts, cultural and heritage programs will also be delivered.

Highlights include \$500,000 for design work on stage three of the Redbank Plains Road upgrade and \$451,000 for the installation of new kerb and channel along Child Street at Riverview between Hales and Webb streets.

Money has also been set aside for the construction of a new playground and shade shelter at Eagle Street Park, Collingwood Park.
