Ipswich City Council Small Business Funding Program (Round 2) provides funding for four (4) funding areas. This factsheet will examine the **Professional Services** funding area.

What providers are eligible under professional services?

- accountants
- financial planners
- solicitors.

NOTE: services provided must be from an accredited provider, hence only the above are approved suppliers.

What items are eligible under professional services?

Below is an incomprehensive list of services provided by accountants, financial planners and/or solicitors which are eligible for funding:

- BAS Lodgement
- bookkeeping and payroll support
- cash flow analysis
- auditing
- tax planning
- management accounting
- valuation
- risk management and planning
- debt management
- emergency funds management
- business acquisitions
- business structure advice
- governance and succession planning
- lease negotiations
- contract support
- corporate advisory and compliance.

What information do I need to provide for the application?

- name of the professional service provider
- total cost of service
- a justification about how the professional service will assist your business to recover from financial impacts of COVID-19
- supporting documentation
 - quote or invoice from professional service provider including proposed works, or
 - receipt or payment or balanced invoice.
