Property owners wishing to landscape nature strips adjacent to their property boundary may do so under certain conditions without approval. These conditions are outlined in the Landscaping on Nature Strips Fact Sheet. Where the landscaping cannot be constructed in accordance with the Standard Conditions the property owner will need to apply for a permit.
