Assisting Ipswich seniors to continue living independently

Eligible members of the community (seniors, people with disabilities and their carers) will be allowed to travel by taxi from home to **Brassall Shopping Centre**, for only \$2 per person each way.

Yellow Cabs will provide the service and the costs will be subsidised by Brassall Shopping Centre.

How does the Program work?

The service is available in selected suburbs, and will operate now on **Monday to Friday**.

To book a taxi, you will need to contact Yellow Cabs on **(07) 3363 2373 before midday** on the day before you wish to travel. Then, on the date requested, the taxi will pick you up from your home at approximately **9.00 am** and take you to Brassall Shopping Centre. You will then return to the designated pick up spot to be collected by taxi at **12.30 pm** and returned home.

Who is eligible to participate in the Program?

You must be in receipt of a full Australian Government Age Pension or a full Disability Support Pension, and your carer (if applicable) must be in receipt of a full Australian Government Carer's Allowance. In addition to this, you must reside in one of the following suburbs:

- Brassall
- Coalfalls
- North Ipswich
- Sadliers Crossing
- Tivoli
- Woodend

How to book your \$2 Taxi

Call **(07) 3363 2373** before midday on the day before you wish to travel and let the operator know you are wanting to join or order an Ipswich City Heart Cab. To be eligible for the subsidy, you must be in receipt of a full Australian Government Pension as listed above.
