Introducing council's new procurement model

Ipswich City Council has adopted a new procurement model which simplifies and streamlines council's procurement processes. It provides industry with greater consistency when dealing with council, and the community with a better understanding around commercial decisions made.

What does this mean for suppliers?

To do business with council from 1 December 2019, you will need to register in the VendorPanel Marketplace.

The **VendorPanel Marketplace** is council's main sourcing platform. It is a simple system that connects suppliers directly with buyers.

Registration takes less than 2 minutes and will provide you with access to a wider market than just Ipswich City Council.

How to register with VendorPanel

- 1 Register via the 'VendorPanel Marketplace' It's FREE and only takes a couple of minutes.

- 2 Once you have registered you will be able to add colleagues to your company profile.

You and your colleagues must be registered to be invited to respond to new projects and opportunities and will then be able to submit quotes and proposals.


