
Never miss your bin day again

- Food jars
- Jam jars

- Sauce bottles

METAL (EMPTY STEEL AND ALUMINIUM ITEMS)

- Aerosol cans
- Aluminium cans (e.g. soft drink)
- Aluminium foil trays (e.g. pie)
- Food tin cans
- Pet food tin cans

3 PLASTIC

- Bathroom bottles and containers
- ✓ Detergent bottles
- Food storage containers
- ✓ Ice cream containers
- Juice and cordial bottles
- Laundry bottles and containers
- Milk bottles

- ✓ Plastic bottle tops and lids
- ✓ Plastic plates
- Plastic take-away food containers
- Sauce bottles
- Soft drink bottles
- ✓ Yoghurt containers
- Shampoo and conditioner bottles

4 CARDBOARD

- Carboard beer cartons
- Cardboard food boxes (e.g. cereal)
- Egg cartons

- Food cartons
- Milk and juice cartons (not long life)
- Pizza boxes

- ✓ Brochures
- Envelopes with or without plastic window
- Gift wrapping paper (no foil or glitter)
- Greeting cards
- Junk mail
- ✓ Loose office paper

- Magazines
- Newspaper
- Paper plates
- ✓ Paper tubes (e.g. toilet)
- Postcards
- Post-it notes
- ✓ Telephone directories

What **CAN'T** go in your recycle bin?

NEVER PUT IN YOUR RECYCLING BIN

- × Batteries
- × Broken glassware
- Bubble wrap and shrink wrap
- × Ceramics
- X Clothing, shoes and textiles
- × Crockery
- Dirty tissues or serviettes
- × Disposable nappies
- × Electrical wire
- × Fishing line
- × Food scraps
- × Garbage
- Garden and lawn clippings

- × Light bulbs
- × Mirrors or plate glass
- Packaging
 not requiring
 refrigeration
 (e.g. long life milk,
 milk products, juices)
- × Plastic bags
- × Pyrex ovenware
- Scrap metal and other car parts
- × Styrofoam
- × Syringes
- × Toys
- Waxed cardboard/paper
- × Wire coat hangers
